“Revitalization Tax Exemption”

Prince George, BC- In tonight’s City Council meeting, Council received the Revitalization Tax Exemption Program Downtown Prince George Report.

In November of 2009, Council approved for immediate action the Downtown Partnership recommendation that the City of Prince George “advocate for changes to the Community Charter for revitalization tax exemptions beyond the current limit of 10 years to 20, 30, or 40 years; or equivalent measures that will aid in the achievement of the desired downtown revitalization outcomes”.

Stakeholders are invited to provide written submissions to Council regarding the findings presented in the Revitalization Tax Exemption Program Downtown Report by 5:00 p.m. July 12, 2010. Submissions can be mailed to the City of Prince George, or sent via email to RTesubmissions@city.pg.bc.ca
